The Corporation of the Township of Woolwich

By-law No. XX-2022

A By-law to Permanently Close Part of a
Forced Road known as Woolwich Township Road No. 60 Through Lot 64,
German Company Tract, in the Township of Woolwich, in the
Regional Municipality of Waterloo

WHEREAS Section 34 of the *Municipal Act, 2001,* S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended (the "*Act*"), authorizes a Municipality to pass by-laws to permanently close any highway or part of a highway;

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of the Township of Woolwich owns and has jurisdiction over the highway described as the Forced Road known as Woolwich Township Road No. 60, through Lot 64, German Company Tract, pursuant to the *Act*;

AND WHEREAS the Middlebrook bridge crossing the Grand River has been closed to vehicular traffic for public safety reasons, and Council deems it appropriate to formally stop up and close the portions of Township Road No. 60 at each end of the bridge;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WOOLWICH HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. **THAT** portions of the Forced Road known as Woolwich Township Road No. 60, being part of Lot 64, German Company Tract, and more particularly described as Parts 1 and 2, Reference Plan 58R-21367 (being parts of PIN 22214-0005 (LT)) are hereby permanently stopped up and closed and the highway dedication removed;
- 2. **THAT** the Head of Council and Clerk of the Township of Woolwich are hereby authorized to execute such authorizations, forms and other documents on behalf of the Township as may be necessary for the above stated purpose;
- 3. **THAT** where the provisions of any other by-law are inconsistent with the provisions of this by-law, the provisions of this by-law shall prevail;
- 4. THAT this by-law is deemed to come into force and take effect upon its final passing.
